**DIRECTIONS TO TRADEPORT
4244 International Parkway, ATL 30354**

Directions: EPD's Tradeport Facility is located south of
Atlanta on the east side of I-75 just north of the
intersection of I-75 and I-285.

From Atlanta on I-75

Take I-75 south to exit 239. This will be after the I-75 and I-85
split. This exit ramp is for access to Central Ave.,
Henry Ford Blvd. and Charles W. Grant Pkwy.
Follow the frontage road to Charles W. Grant Pkwy.
Take a left on Charles W. Grant Pkwy. Take a right
at the second traffic light onto International
Parkway. Turn left at the first road. Proceed
straight ahead towards the flagpole island, circle
around flagpole island continuing in a straight
direction. At end of the drive, turn right and proceed
approximately 50 feet. Entrance to Suite 116
(Training Room) is on the left.

From the south on I-75

Take the first exit to the right after you cross under I-285. This
exit is number 239 for Central Ave., Henry Ford
Blvd., and Charles W. Grant Pkwy. This ramp also
serves as the entrance ramp from I-285 onto I-75.
Take the first right off exit 239, which is Charles W.
Grant Pkwy. (This is a horseshoe exit). At the light,
go straight onto International Parkway. Turn left at
the first road. Proceed straight ahead towards the
flagpole island, circle around flagpole island
continuing in a straight direction. At end of the
drive, turn right and proceed approximately 50 feet.
Entrance to Suite 116 (Training Room) is on the left.

From I-285 - Either direction

Take the I-75 North exit. The entrance ramp onto I-75 is also
the exit ramp onto Charles W. Grant Pkwy., so stay
in the extreme right hand lane and exit to Charles
W. Grant Pkwy. (This is a horseshoe exit). At the
light, go straight onto International Parkway. Turn
left at the first road. Proceed straight ahead
towards the flagpole island, circle around flagpole
island continuing in a straight direction. At end of
the drive, turn right and proceed approximately 50
feet. Entrance to Suite 116 (Training Room) is on
the left.
